GETTING TO BEAUTIFUL VICTORIA, BC

BY AIR + BY SEA

ALASKA AIRLINES

Several airlines, including Alaska Airlines and Air Canada, offer flights to Victoria daily. Make sure to arrange transportation ahead of time from Victoria International Airport - it's about a 35 minute drive to the city.

FLOAT PLANES

Kenmore Air flies from Seattle's Lake Union to Victoria's Inner Harbour in a scenic 45 minutes. If you're traveling from Vancouver, Harbour Air is a quick 25-minute soar over the Gulf Islands.

BC FERRIES

With sailings almost every hour during summer months, BC Ferries brings the coast within reach for car and foot passengers traveling from the mainland to Victoria. This scenic sail takes 1 hour 35 minutes.


THE CLIPPER

The foot passenger-only Clipper is a highspeed catamaran that runs between Seattle and Victoria in just under three hours. Disembarking in the downtown core of both cities, it's an excellent way to travel for a weekend trip.

BLACK BALL FERRY

The Black Ball Ferry runs from Port Angeles across the Juan de Fuca Strait, with car and foot passengers disembarking in downtown Victoria. The MV Coho is a retro vessel, with comfy seating during its 90-minute voyage.
